- **War with Iraq will cost taxpayers hundreds of billions of dollars**

Unlike the 1991 war, U.S. taxpayers will foot the entire bill for this war, greatly adding to the record deficit projections, which *do not* include any accounting for war expenses.

- **Inspections work**

Previous UN inspections identified and destroyed 90 to 95% of all Iraqi weapons of mass destruction. Generals Schwarzkopf, Zinni, Clark and other U.S. military leaders believe UN inspections should be allowed to continue.

- **Women, children and other civilians will be the main victims even with "smart bombs"**

The UN estimates that there may be as many as 500,000 casualties during the first phase of attack, and over 2 million children under five and 1 million pregnant and lactating women will suffer serious malnutrition in the aftermath; "furthermore, the outbreak of diseases in epidemic if not pandemic proportions is very likely."

- **Attacking Iraq will make the U.S. less secure**
